In this book, Rivera writes about her father's feelings and moods; the anger and eccentricities of a genius of art, but also the sensitivity of a man who knew how to live up to the political and social circumstances of his time.

CHELIS LOPEZ is the host and producer of KPOO 89.5FM programs Pajaro Latinoamericano and Andanzas. She is also host of the Línea Abierta show on Radio Bilingue, the National Latino Public Radio Network, and for over ten years, has moderated the Spanish reading group "Rincón Literario" at the San Francisco Public Library main branch.
